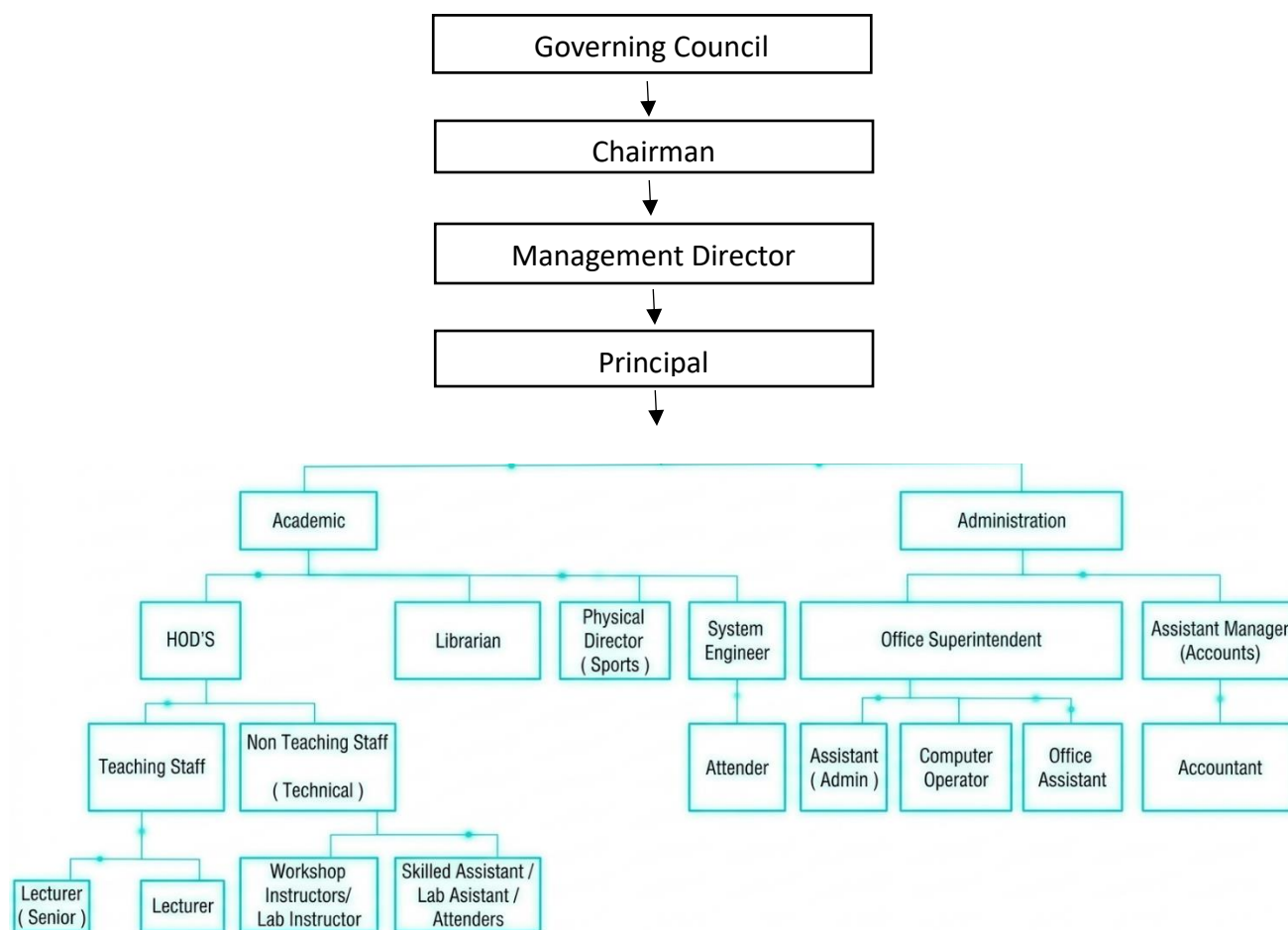

5.4. Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff & students

A student Grievance Redressal committee has been duly constituted on 15th November 2025 for the academic year 2025 - 2026 in compliance of directions of the AICTE and Directorate of Technical Education.

To redress the individual and collective grievances of the students and the staff at TSHPC, a grievance redressal mechanism has been devised. An informal grievance redressal system was previously in place under the direct supervision of the Principal and the Managing Director of the institution.

However, a formal system was put in place with the provision of suggestion boxes to address the lodged grievances and judge each one through its merit. This also includes matters of harassment or bullying. Any one with grievance may also approach the department members in person directly or consult with the Officer in-Charge of the Students' Grievance Cell. However,

aggrieved persons who are unwilling to appear directly could use the letterbox/ suggestion box of the Grievance Cell at the Administrative Block.

The Grievances may broadly include the following complaints of the aggrieved students

- a) Academic
- b) Non-Academic
- c) Grievance related to Assessment
- d) Grievance related to Victimization
- e) Grievance related to Attendance
- f) Grievance related to charging of fees
- g) Grievance regarding conducting of Examinations
- h) Harassment by colleague students or the teachers etc.,

There will be Grievance Redressal Committees at the Department / Institutes / central level to deal with the grievances of the students and staff.

A) Department grievance committee will be as under:

- ii) Up to 3 faculties to be nominated by the Head of Department

This committee will deal with the Grievance related to Academic and Administrative matters of the Department.

12.CRITERIA AND WEIGHTAGES FOR ADMISSION

QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION:

A)Minimum Qualification for 1st year

A pass in 10th STD ,S.S.L.C./Matric/CBSE(10 Year schooling) .(or) Any other Qualification recognized as equivalent to the above by the Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu.

B)Minimum Qualification for II year Direct entry

A pass in +2 , HSC (academic , Vocational, Pure Science) or Any other Qualification recognized as equivalent to the above by the Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu.

- i) A pass in +2 Academic with Maths, Physics & Chemistry
- ii) A pass in +2 with Pure Science also
- iii) A pass in +2 vocational subjects with Maths or Physics or Chemistry
- iv) A pass in +2 Commerce subjects. v) A pass in 2 years **ITI** with 10th Std.

Mark Rule:

For qualifying for admission candidates belonging to All communities should secure the Pass marks in All Subjects.

Age Limit:

There is no age limit for admission in Polytechnic College for any community as per Govt .G.O.

Each application should be accompanied by Xerox copies of the following:

- a) X Std. Mark Sheet / XII Mark sheet / ITI Mark Sheet or its equivalent as the case may be.
- b) Transfer Certificate from the School last studied
- c) Conduct Certificate from the Head of the School last studied.
- d) Community Certificate issued by a competent authority in the case of BC/MBC/SC/ST.
- e) Foreign students must also submit:

- 1) No Objection Certificate from Education Department, Government of India.
- 2) Production of valid student Visa & Passport.

i) Candidates who satisfy the eligibility criteria will receive interview cards which are valid only until the date specified. The receipt of interview cards does not guarantee admission. At the time of interview the College Office will scrutinize all the original certificates of the candidate. Selected candidates will be issued admission cards after payment of fees.

ii) The selected candidates at time of admission will produce all the original certificates (Original mark sheet, Transfer certificate, and Community certificate etc.,) with two passport size photograph in the college and they will not be returned till the completion of the course. They are therefore advised to take sufficient xerox copies of all certificates before submitting the originals to the college.

iii) Fees once paid will not be refunded. Students dismissed on disciplinary grounds will forfeit the entire fees.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on this 22nd day of January, 2026,

BY AND BETWEEN

- f) The PARTY 2 hereby acknowledges that Party 1 possesses competitively valuable Confidential Information regarding their current and future training solutions for the semiconductor industry and Engineers/Students from all over the world, especially the rates offered by PARTY 1 to PARTY 2, and special engagement fees.
- g) During the tenure of the MOU both PARTY 1 and PARTY 2 will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MOU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MOU.
- h) Both PARTY 1 and PARTY 2 shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this agreement or projects.

4. **Amendments**

5. **Effective date and Duration of the MOU**

- c) During its period, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than three months (3) by either party. - c) After this Agreement has been signed, all preceding understandings/ negotiations and correspondence pertaining to it shall become null and void.
- d) All obligations created by this Agreement shall survive change or termination of the PARTIES' business relationship for a period of no more than three (3) years.
- e) PARTY 1 reserves the right to substitute ~~an~~ **institute(s)**
- f) Course prices are subject to change without notice
- g) Once you accept and have your staff enroll in the training program offered by PARTY 1, automatically the privacy policy and terms and conditions as mentioned in the website will be legally binding on the staff, students, management and faculty of PARTY 2
